

SUMMARY OF INFORMATION COLLECTION REQUEST

Title: 10 CFR 54, Requirements for Renewal of Operating Licenses for Nuclear Power Plants (Final OCP)

Current Burden/Responses: 89,333 hours/1.33 responses

Proposed Burden/Responses: 432,333 hours/20 responses (6 responses + 14 recordkeepers)

Number of Respondents: 14 (6 annual respondents + 8 current recordkeepers)

Reasons for Changes in Burden/Responses:

There is no change in the estimated burden per application. However, an average of 6 applications are expected to be submitted annually during this clearance renewal, as opposed to an estimated one annually during the last clearance period. Additionally, the method of calculating responses and respondents has changed. In the previous clearance period, the number of responses was annualized over the clearance period. In this renewal, total annual responses plus annualized + current recordkeepers is used as the basis for responses, and annual respondents + recordkeepers for the applications in-house is used as the basis for respondents.
