SUBJECT: D. C. COOK UNITS 1 AND 2 - WITHDRAWAL OF AN AMENDMENT REQUEST
(TAC NOS. 75396 AND 75397)

By letter dated December 5, 1989, (AEP:NRC:1107) you applied for an amendment to the D. C. Cook Unit Nos. 1 and 2 operating license Nos. DPR-58 and DPR-74. The proposed amendments would have revised Technical Specification (TS) definition 1.4, "Operational Mode", to clarify the definition of Mode 6 (refueling). A number of other TS changes were included to clarify equipment operability requirements depending on whether the reactor vessel contains fuel. Subsequently, by letter dated September 21, 1990, you withdrew the amendment request.

The Commission has filed the enclosed Notice of Withdrawal of Application for Amendment to Facility Operating License with the Office of the Federal Register for publication.

NOTICE OF WITHDRAWAL OF APPLICATION FOR
AMENDMENT TO FACILITY OPERATING LICENSE

The United States Nuclear Regulatory Commission (the Commission) has granted the request of Indiana Michigan Power Company (the licensee) to withdraw its December 5, 1989, application for proposed amendment to Facility Operating License Nos. DPR-58 and DPR-74 for the Donald C. Cook Nuclear Power Plant, Unit Nos. 1 and 2, located in Berrien County, Michigan.

The proposed amendment would have revised Technical Specification (TS) definition 1.4, "Operational Mode," to clarify the definition of Mode 6 (refueling). A number of other TS changes were included to clarify equipment operability requirements to depending on whether the reactor vessel contains fuel.

The Commission had previously issued a Notice of Consideration of Issuance to Amendment published in the FEDERAL REGISTER On April 4, 1990 (55 FR 12596). However, by letter dated September 21, 1990, the licensee withdrew the proposed change.

For further details with respect to this action, see the application for amendment dated December 5, 1989, and the licensee's letter dated September 21, 1990 which withdrew the application for license amendment. The above documents are available for public inspection at the Commission's Public Document Room, 2120 L Street, N.W., Washington, D. C., and at the Maude Preston Palenske Memorial Library, 500 Market Street, St. Joseph, Michigan 49085.
