Gentlemen:

Pursuant to the Atomic Energy Act of 1954 and Section 40.21 of the Code of Federal Regulations, Title 10 - Atomic Energy, Chapter 1, Part 40 - Control of Source Material, and in view of the representations made in your application for license, you are hereby authorized:

To receive possession of and title to two and one-half ($2\frac{1}{2}$) pounds of natural uranium metal presently in your stock of AEC-owned material through purchase in accordance with the procedure outlined in a separate communication.

To transfer to Philip Brothers, Inc., 70 Pine St., New York City, for export by that Company under the terms of AEC export license S-2505, one (1) kilogram of natural uranium metal powder.

This license is subject to all the provisions of the Atomic Energy Act of 1954 now or hereafter in effect and to all the valid rules and regulations of the U. S. Atomic Energy Commission.

Neither this license nor any right under this license shall be assigned or otherwise transferred in violation of the provisions of the Atomic Energy Act of 1954.

This license shall expire at 12:01 a.m., E.S.T., on January 1, 1956 or on delivery of the above licensed material to Philip Brothers, Inc., whichever occurs earlier.
