Gentlemen:

By our letter dated July 8, 1958, we requested your Division of Industrial Development (Mr. Frank K. Pittman) to sell to this company two slugs produced under our Contract AT(30-1)-GEN-1293 with the Savannah River Operations Office. These slugs are production rejects and we desire to use them at various exhibits and conferences.

By letter dated July 28, 1958, the Division of Industrial Development informed us that they were authorizing the Manager of the Savannah River Operations Office to sell the slugs to us. However, we were advised that we must first obtain an allotment of material from you.

The slugs in question are identified as follows:

- 1.  $6\frac{1}{2}$  long, 1" diameter solid, contains thorium.
- 2.  $8\frac{1}{2}$  long,  $1\frac{1}{4}$  overall diameter  $(\frac{1}{2}$  hole), contains natural uranium

Slug No. 1 contains 1.89 pounds or approximately .86 of a kilogram of thorium. Slug No. 2 contains 3.87 pounds or approximately 1.76 kilograms of natural uranium.

Accordingly, it is hereby requested that the above material be allotted to our Source Material License, C-3700.
