Dear Dr. Solon:

The Bayside, New York site, formerly operated by the Sylvania Corning Corporation during the 1950's, involved metallurgical work with uranium and thorium. We understand that excavation and construction has taken place during the past few years and, while some soil samples and gamma surveys were taken as construction proceeded, we are in need of information on future plans for that site. Would you please provide up-to-date information on site construction and current status and future plans for disposition of the site so that we may plan appropriately.

I should mention that all analysis and surveys conducted to date have not indicated radiological conditions in excess of normal background for that area of New York.
