
The Commission has issued the enclosed Amendment No. 67 to Provisional Operating License No. DPR-19 and Amendment No. 59 to Facility Operating License No. DPR-25 for the Dresden Nuclear Power Station, Units 2 and 3, respectively. These amendments consist of changes to the Technical Specifications as proposed in your application dated October 14, 1980, and supplemented by your letter dated October 22, 1981, and as modified during subsequent discussions with your staff.

The amendments expand the Technical Specifications for the Scram Discharge Volume (SDV) to include surveillance requirements for the SDV vent and drain valves and Limiting Conditions for Operation/surveillance requirements for the Reactor Protection System and Control Rod Block SDV limit switches.

In addition, the amendment for Dresden Unit 3 includes changes to the Technical Specifications as proposed in your letter dated March 18, 1982. These changes reflect Technical Specification improvements as a result of long-term SDV modifications. These modifications were undertaken to comply with revised design and performance criteria set forth in the staff's December 1, 1980 Generic Safety Evaluation Report, "BWR Scram Discharge Volume," and have been implemented for Unit 3 during the current refueling outage.

Copies of our Safety Evaluation and Notice of Issuance are also enclosed.

1. The Nuclear Regulatory Commission (the Commission) has found that:
  - A. The application for amendment by the Commonwealth Edison Company (the licensee) dated October 14, 1980 and supplemented by letter dated October 22, 1981 complies with the standards and requirements of the Atomic Energy Act of 1954, as amended (the Act), and the Commission's regulations set forth in 10 CFR Chapter I;
  - B. The facility will operate in conformity with the application, the provisions of the Act, and the rules and regulations of the Commission;
  - C. There is reasonable assurance (i) that the activities authorized by this amendment can be conducted without endangering the health and safety of the public, and (ii) that such activities will be conducted in compliance with the Commission's regulations;
  - D. The issuance of this amendment will not be inimical to the common defense and security or to the health and safety of the public; and
  - E. The issuance of this amendment is in accordance with 10 CFR Part 51 of the Commission's regulations and all applicable requirements have been satisfied.
2. Accordingly, the license is amended by changes to the Technical Specifications as indicated in the attachment to this license amendment, and paragraph 3.B of Provisional License No. DPR-19 is hereby amended to read as follows:

B. Technical Specifications

The Technical Specifications contained in Appendix A, as revised through Amendment No. 67, are hereby incorporated in the license. The licensee shall operate the facility in accordance with the Technical Specifications.

3. This license amendment is effective as of the date of its issuance.
