Electronic Information Exchange

- What is it?

What is it?

- A voluntary program that currently applies to: Part 50 submitters; Parts 40 and 70 submitters with exemption; other government agencies; & pilot program participants.
- May submit digitally signed documents electronically via internet or by CD-ROM via mail.
- Documents are time/date stamped when received by EIE server.
- NRC is currently receiving , but not sending documents by EIE.

Why use it?

- No copies to make.
- Faster transmittal of documents.
- Easier for the NRC to electronically file and distribute (ADAMS).
- It's the future.
