The Commission has filed the enclosed "Notice of Issuance of Amendment to Facility Operating License" with the Office of the Federal Register for publication. The notice related to the issuance of Amendment No. 94 to Facility Operating License No. DPR-25 for Dresden Nuclear Power Station, Unit 3. The amendment issued revises the Technical Specifications to support: 1) changes specific to Cycle 11 load fuel and analyses; 2) changes resulting from analyses performed to allow equipment out-of-services; and 3) changes provided for clarification or as administrative changes. The amendment also revises the license to delete a condition requiring a Safety Evaluation for coastdown operation with abnormal feedwater temperature.

The U. S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (Commission) has issued Amendment No. 94 to Facility Operating License No. DPR-25 issued to Commonwealth Edison Company, which revises the Technical Specifications for operation of the Dresden Nuclear Power Station, Unit No. 3, located in Grundy County, Illinois.

The amendment issued revises the Technical Specifications to support: 1) changes specific to Cycle 11 reload fuel and analyses; 2) changes resulting from analyses performed to allow equipment out-of-service; and 3) changes provided for clarification or as administrative changes. The amendment also revises the license to delete a condition requiring a safety evaluation for coastdown operation with abnormal feedwater temperature.

The application for the amendment complies with the standards and requirements of the Atomic Energy Act of 1954, as amended (the Act), and the Commission's rules and regulations. The Commission has made appropriate findings as required by the Act and the Commission's rules and regulations in 10 CFR Chapter I, which are set forth in the license amendment.


Notice of Consideration of Issuance of Amendment and Opportunity for Hearing in connection with this was published in the FEDERAL REGISTER on May 13, 1988 (53 FR 17129). No request for a hearing or petition for leave to intervene was filed following this notice.

Also in connection with this action, the Commission prepared an Environmental Assessment and Finding of No Significant Impact which was published in the FEDERAL REGISTER on May 23, 1988 (53 FR 18361).
