Dear Mr. Farrar:

The U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (Commission) has issued the enclosed Amendment No. 113 to Facility Operating License No. NPF-11 and Amendment No. 98 to Facility Operating License No. NPF-18 for the LaSalle County Station, Units 1 and 2, respectively. The amendments are in response to your application dated December 21, 1995.

The amendments delete the requirement to place the reactor mode switch in the Shutdown position if a stuck open safety/relief valve can not be closed within 2 minutes. The operator will still be required to scram the reactor if suppression pool average water temperature reaches 110 degrees Fahrenheit or greater. The amendment also includes editorial changes to the index pages.

A copy of the Safety Evaluation is also enclosed. The Notice of Issuance will be included in the Commission's biweekly <u>Federal</u> <u>Register</u> notice.
