Gentlemen:

Your letter dated May 15, 1970 provided information relative to construction aspects of the Dresden Nuclear Power Station Units 2 and 3 reactor and turbine building ventilation systems. Construction of the Unit 3 ventilation system will be completed to permit concurrent operation of the Dresden Units 2 and 3 ventilation system.

We have reviewed the proposed change and have determined that it does not involve an unreviewed safety question or require a change to the Technical Specifications of Facility License No. DFR-19. Consequently, you may perform the proposed change as described in your letter dated May 15, 1970, in accordance with paragraph 50.59(a) of 10 CFR Part 50 without prior Commission authorization. When the change is carried out, it should be recorded and reported as provided in 50.59(b).
