SUBJECT: DELETION OF ORGANIZATION CHARTS FROM TECHNICAL SPECIFICATIONS
(TAC NOS. 69808, 69809, 69716, and 69717)

Re: Quad Cities Nuclear Power Station, Units 1 and 2 and Dresden Nuclear
Power Station, Units 2 and 3

The Commission has issued the enclosed Amendment Nos. 117 and 113 to Facility Operating License Nos. DPR-29 and DPR-30 for the Quad Cities Nuclear Power Station, Units 1 and 2 and Amendment Nos. 105 and 100 to Provisional Operating License No. DPR-19 and Facility Operating License No. DPR-25 for the Dresden Nuclear Power Station, Units 2 and 3 respectively. These amendments are in response to your applications dated February 17 and 21, 1989 and March 20, 1989 to remove station and corporate organization charts from the Technical Specifications (TS). In accordance with Generic Letter 88-06, these charts are to be maintained in the Commonwealth Edison Company (CECo) Quality Assurance Manual or Management Plan, which are referenced by TS. Furthermore, onsite and corporate position titles, descriptions, responsibilities, and lines of authority in TS Section 6 are revised to reflect the planned CECo reorganization.

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A copy of the related Safety Evaluation is also enclosed. A Notice of Issuance will be included in the Commission's biweekly Federal Register notices.
