SIGNIFICANT IMPACT (TAC NOS. M81299, M81300, M81301 AND M81302)

By letter dated January 30, 1992, the Commission transmitted an
"Environmental Assessment and Finding of No Significant Impact" (EA) for a
proposed exemption from Appendix J to 10 CFR Part 50 related to the two-ply
containment penetration expansion bellows at Dresden and Quad Cities Nuclear
Power Stations. That EA inadvertently referenced Dresden Units 2 and 3 as
Dresden Units 1 and 2. A copy of the "Correction to Environmental Assessment

CORRECTION TO ENVIRONMENTAL ASSESSMENT
AND FINDING OF NO SIGNIFICANT IMPACT

By letter dated November 12, 1991, Commonwealth Edison Company (the licensee) requested an exemption from certain Type B (local leak rate) testing requirements of Appendix J to 10 CFR Part 50 relating to the Dresden and Quad Cities two-ply containment penetration expansion bellows.

The related Environmental Assessment and Finding of No Significant Impact (Environmental Assessment) was published in the FEDERAL REGISTER on February 6, 1992 (57 FR 4651). The Environmental Assessment referred to Dresden Nuclear Power Station, Units 1 and 2, and should have referred to Units 2 and 3. Therefore, the referenced Environmental Assessment is hereby corrected to apply to Dresden Nuclear Power Station, Units 2 and 3.
