The Commission issued Amendment Nos. 137 and 131 to Appendix A of Facility Operating License Nos. DPR-19 and DPR-25 and Amendment Nos. 158 and 154 to Facility Operating License Nos. DPR-29 and DPR-30 on July 27, 1995. By letter dated August 3, 1995, Commonwealth Edison Company informed the Commission that it would implement the portion of the amendment relating to the scram time testing of control rods (Technical Specification Upgrade Program (TSUP) Surveillance Requirement (SR) 4.3.D.3) prior to implementation of the remaining portions of the amendments. The licensee will implement this new SR as Technical Specification (TS) 4.3.C.2. The staff has reviewed the TS pages that include the revised SR. These TS pages should adequately control the partial implementation. It is the staff's understanding that no other portions of Amendment Nos. 137, 131, 158, or 154 will be implemented until full implementation of the TSUP. Also in the August 3, 1995, letter, the licensee formally withdrew a supplemental amendment request dated July 19, 1995, which requested expedited approval of TSUP 4.3.D.3. Upon issuance of the above listed amendments, the supplemental amendment request was no longer necessary.
