

concluded that the granting of the proposed exemption is authorized by law, will not endanger life or property or the common defense and security, and is otherwise in the public interest.

Accordingly, the Commission hereby authorizes you to construct those portions of the reactor facilities heretofore mentioned and described and requested in your letter dated June 4, 1970, prior to the issuance of a construction permit.

I wish to emphasize that the granting of this exemption shall have no bearing upon the subsequent granting or denial of a construction permit for the proposed Davis-Besse Nuclear Power Station, any work performed pursuant to this exemption shall be performed entirely at the risk of The Toledo Edison Company et al. Furthermore, the granting of this exemption does not constitute an approval of the type or adequacy of the method of its installation.
