SUBJECT: AMENDMENT NO. 135 TO FACILITY OPERATING LICENSE NO. NPF-3
(TAC NOS. 66417 AND 73024)

The Commission has issued Amendment No. 135 to Facility Operating License No. NPF-3 for the Davis-Besse Nuclear Power Station, Unit No. 1. The amendment revises the Technical Specifications in response to your applications dated November 2, 1987 and January 5, 1989.

This amendment corrects typographical errors and makes minor word changes to achieve consistency between the Technical Specifications and plant nomenclature. It also deletes certain statements that are no longer necessary because of elapsed time and/or completion of specified actions.

A copy of the Safety Evaluation is also enclosed. Notice of issuance will be included in the Commission's next biweekly Federal Register notice.

AMENDMENT TO FACILITY OPERATING LICENSE

Amendment No. 135
License No. NPF-3

1. The Nuclear Regulatory Commission (the Commission) has found that:
 - A. The applications for amendment by the Toledo Edison Company and The Cleveland Electric Illuminating Company (the licensees) dated November 2, 1987 and January 5, 1989 comply with the standards and requirements of the Atomic Energy Act of 1954, as amended (the Act), and the Commission's rules and regulations set forth in 10 CFR Chapter I;
 - B. The facility will operate in conformity with the applications, the provisions of the Act, and the rules and regulations of the Commission;
 - C. There is reasonable assurance (i) that the activities authorized by this amendment can be conducted without endangering the health and safety of the public, and (ii) that such activities will be conducted in compliance with the Commission's regulations;
 - D. The issuance of this amendment will not be inimical to the common defense and security or to the health and safety of the public; and
 - E. The issuance of this amendment is in accordance with 10 CFR Part 51 of the Commission's regulations and all applicable requirements have been satisfied.
2. Accordingly, the license is amended by changes to the Technical Specifications as indicated in the attachment to this license amendment, and paragraph 2.C.(2) of Facility Operating License No. NPF-3 is hereby amended to read as follows:


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(a) Technical Specifications

The Technical Specifications contained in Appendices A and B, as revised through Amendment No. 135, are hereby incorporated in the license. The Toledo Edison Company shall operate the facility in accordance with the Technical Specifications.

3. This license amendment is effective as of its date of issuance and shall be implemented not later than September 18, 1989.
