Dear Mr. Campbell:

By letter dated May 19, 1999, the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission issued Amendment No. 231 to Facility Operating License No. NPF-3 for the Davis-Besse Nuclear Power Station, Unit 1. The amendment revised the Technical Specifications (TSs) administrative requirements related to: TS 6.5.1.6, Station Review Board Responsibilities; TS 6.8.4.d, Radioactive Effluent Controls Program; TS 6.10, Records Retention; TS 6.11, Radiation Protection Program; TS 6.12, High Radiation Area; and TS 6.15, Offsite Dose Calculation Manual.

The instruction sheet issued with the amendment includes instructions to remove the existing TS page 6-14 and insert a new TS page 6-14. Subsequent to issuing the amendment, the staff noticed that TS page 6-14 was not affected by the May 19, 1999, amendment, and thus appropriately was not provided. Enclosed is a new instruction page which correctly omits any reference to page 6-14. We apologize for any inconvenience this may have caused.
