Search of the Information Requirements Control Automated System (IRCAS): IRCAS was searched on March 29, 2002. No duplication was found.

Abstract: The NRC Form 536 serves as a vehicle for NRC to request that all commercial power reactor licensees and applicants for an operating license voluntarily send to the NRC: (1) their projected number of candidates for operator licensing initial examinations; (2) the estimated dates of the examinations; (3) an indication of whether the examination will be facility developed or NRC developed; and (4) the estimated number of individuals who will use the Generic Fundamentals Examination (GFE) for that calendar year. This information will be used to plan budgets and resources for the administration of operator examinations.
