Westinghouse Test Reactor Licensing Files and Contract Files



Leader Professional Services, Inc. is interested in reviewing the following records now in the possession of the NRC related to former US Atomic Energy Commission (AEC) licenses and contracts:

- 1. Westinghouse Test Reactor (WTR) Operating License TR-2, specifically all correspondence, reports, memos, data, etc. pertaining to the April 3, 1960 fuel element failure incident and possible connections to work performed at the WTR under AEC prime and sub-contracts, and WTR response actions and costs between 1958 and 1985. We are also interested in obtaining records from the same period, 1958 through 1985, of all Special Nuclear Materials shipments to and from the WTR under TR-2 and other relevant licenses, contracts, or subcontracts, as well as copies of original Operating License TR-2 and any amendments that were in effect prior to 1980, including all attached exhibits, maps, insurance policies, indemnification statements, etc. At this time, we do not require access to WTR design, construction or routine operating data, nor the WTR TR-2 records that are available through the NRC Public Reading Room.
- 2. AEC Prime Contract No. AT(38-1)-200 with East Central Nuclear Group, Inc. (ECNG), and ECNG's Letter Agreement (dated 6/10/59) and Subcontract with Westinghouse Electric Corp. (executed 5/16/60), specifically: (i) all correspondence, reports, memos, data, etc. that document the test schedule to be completed in the WTR under the Letter Agreement and Subcontract; (ii) the operating history and disposition of the ECNG- and AEC-owned test "Loop" that was apparently installed at the WTR; (iii) the April 3, 1960 fuel element failure incident at the WTR and subsequent response actions and costs; (iv) records of all Shipments of Special Nuclear Materials, fuel elements, other test apparatus, etc. to and from the WTR from 1958 through 1985; and, (v) copies of original AEC/ECNG Prime Contract AT(38-1)-200 and the associated ECNG/Westinghouse Letter Agreement and Subcontract, including all associated correspondence, exhibits and attachments, plus any relevant amendments.

The subject license and contracts pertain to the Westinghouse Electric Corp. Test Reactor, located at the Waltz Mill site in Madison, Pennsylvania.
