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Dear Mr. Griffin:

The Commission has issued the enclosed Amendment Nos. 88 and 60 to Facility Operating License Nos. DPR-51 and NPF-6 for Arkansas Nuclear One, Unit Nos. 1 and 2 (ANO-1 & 2). These amendments consist of changes to the Technical Specifications (TS) in response to your application dated April 13, 1984 as supplemented by letter dated April 26, 1984. As discussed with and agreed to by members of your staff, these amendments will be effective on January 1, 1985.

The amendments revise the TS to incorporate the requirements of Appendix I of 10 CFR Part 50 as the Radiological Effluent Technical Specifications (RETS). The RETS provide new TS sections defining limiting conditions of operation and surveillance requirements for radiological liquid and gaseous effluent monitoring; concentration, dose, and treatment of liquid, gaseous and solid wastes; total dose; radiological environmental monitoring. In addition, some changes are made in administrative controls, specifically dealing with the Process Control Program (PCP) and the Offsite Dose Calculation Manual (OPCM).

A copy of the Safety Evaluation with attached Technical Evaluation Report is enclosed. The notice of issuance will be included in the Commission's next monthly Federal Register notice.

It should be noted that the issuance of these amendments does not complete our actions related to this subject in that you have yet to request deletion of the existing RETS from the Appendix B TS and you need to correct those discrepancies that we found during our review of your ODCM submitted by letter dated April 13, 1984. The discrepancies have been discussed with members of your staff. You are requested within 90 days of receipt of this letter to submit an application for amendment which would delete the existing RETS from the Appendix B TS and to correct the discrepancies from the ODCM.

The reporting and/or recordkeeping requirements of this letter affect fewer than ten respondents; therefore, OMB clearance is not required under P.L. 96-511.
