SUBJECT: SUMMARY OF PRESENTATION TO EPRI STEAM GENERATOR  
TECHNICAL ADVISORY GROUP

On March 7, 2002, I attended a portion of the Electric Power Research Institute (EPRI) Steam Generator (SG) Technical Advisory Group (TAG) meeting. I was requested to attend this meeting to provide technical feedback from the NRC's visits to the EPRI Non-Destructive Examination (NDE) Center in March 2001 and January 2002.

In preparing for the presentation, I solicited input from other NRC staff (including consultants and contractors) who participated in these trips to the NDE center. The attached slides summarize the feedback I provided, and they incorporate the feedback I received from other participants in these trips.

Other topics discussed during the portion of the meeting I attended included a summary of past SG TAG accomplishments, research and development results from Sweden, the status of the EPRI steam generator degradation database, and experience with thermally treated Alloy 600 and 690 steam generator tubes. Of particular note from these presentations was the aggressive research and tube-pull program in Sweden.
