- Purpose: The U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) is soliciting stakeholder comments on draft inspection guidance as part of its activities to implement the recently published revision to 10 CFR Part 35, "Medical Use of Byproduct Material." Major emphasis was placed on writing the rule to enable risk-informed and performance-based approaches to regulation of the use of byproduct material. NRC staff is especially interested in stakeholder comments on the proposed draft inspection guidance to help achieve this goal. The workshop will be preceded by an open house to present the opportunity for informal interactions between attendees, both NRC staff and members of the public.
- Participants: The workshops will be conducted as roundtable discussions among invited participants representing the broad spectrum of interests that may be affected by the rule and guidance. The interests include the regulated community, patient's rights interests, the NRC and other Federal and State regulators. Although the focus of the discussion will be among the invited participants, the workshop is open to the public.
