RE: Proposed Rule: Disposal of High-Level Radioactive Wastes in a Proposed Geologic Repository at Yucca Mountain, Nevada.

This NRC proposed rule seriously underestimates the potential dangers associated with future, unpredictable human intrusions over the next several centuries or thousands of years which could breach the proposed repository at Yucca Mountain. The rule would weaken or undo the requirement that the DOE systematically record its decisions that significantly concern safety. Given the grave consequences of radiation leakage from a repository, systematic accountability must be upheld.

Lots can change in ten thousand years; radiation protection standards for the public health and the environment should be more stringent, rather than the less stringent standards NRC puts forth in this proposed rule.
