## REACTOR SITE CRITERIA

These comments are submitted in response to the invitation contained in "Atomic Energy Commission (10 CFR Part 100) Reactor Site Criteria, Notice of Proposed Guides" published in the Federal Register on February 11, 1961.

We have carefully reviewed the proposed guides, and are also represented on the Reactor Safety Committee of the Atomic Industrial Forum. We believe the guides form an excellent basis for formulation of regulations, but feel that it is important to make some changes.

We are in complete accord with the recommendations to be made by the Atomic Industrial Forum, and are a party to those recommendations. We feel that it is particularly important to eliminate Appendix A as part of the regulation, and to avoid defining a population center by a 4/3 rule.

In addition, we would suggest that under the introductory paragraph headed "Statement of Considerations", paragraph (b) and the last two sentences of paragraph (c) be deleted.
