SUBJECT: ANS SPONSORED NRC/UTILITY WORKSHOP

Thank you for agreeing to participate as a speaker for the session on Grid Stability/RTO Issues at the April 23-24, 2002, Utility-NRC Interface workshop. The workshop is being held to foster communications and reach a common understanding on the issues and/or challenges facing industry and the NRC. Invited attendees are representatives from the nuclear power industry in NRC's Region II geographical area and from NRC's Region II Office, the Office of Nuclear Reactor Regulation, and the Office of Nuclear Material Safety and Safeguards. Your presentation is scheduled for April 23, 2002, at 2:00 p.m.

As you can see from the attached agenda, the workshop contains sessions on a broad spectrum of topics, including a special panel on April 24, 2002, to discuss the topic of security at nuclear power plants. The plan for your session is to have you, Kerry Landis from Region II provide the NRC perspective of the issues and challenges facing industry and the NRC in the topic area for approximately 15 - 20 minutes total. There is also a representative from Duke Energy Corporation, who will provide the industry perspective on this same topic for approximately 15 minutes. This will allow 20 - 30 minutes for questions. Each session will be chaired by a facilitator from the NRC and from industry. At the end of each day, these facilitators will provide a summary of the key results from each session. I am anticipating between 100 - 120 individuals participating in the workshop. The workshop will be held at the Wyndham Atlanta Hotel, 160 Spring Street, Atlanta, Georgia. There will be a badge at the registration desk in your name; it entitles you to attend all sessions of the workshop, including the luncheons.
