SUBJECT: ANS SPONSORED NRC/UTILITY WORKSHOP

Thank you for agreeing to participate as a speaker for the session on Control Room Habitability at the April 23-24, 2002, Utility-NRC Interface workshop. The workshop is being held to foster communications and reach a common understanding on the issues and/or challenges facing industry and the NRC. Invited attendees are representatives from the nuclear power industry in NRC's Region II geographical area and from NRC's Region II Office, the Office of Nuclear Reactor Regulation, and the Office of Nuclear Material Safety and Safeguards. Your presentation is scheduled for April 23, 2002, at 1:00 p.m.

As you can see from the attached agenda, the workshop contains sessions on a broad spectrum of topics, including a special panel on April 24, 2002, to discuss the topic of security at nuclear power plants. The plan for your session is to have you and a representative from industry provide your perspective of the issues and challenges facing industry and the NRC in the topic area for approximately 15 minutes each. This will allow for approximately 30 minutes for questions. Each session will be chaired by a facilitator from the NRC and from industry. I am anticipating between 100 - 120 individuals participating in the workshop. The workshop will be held at the Wyndham Atlanta Hotel, 160 Spring Street, Atlanta, Georgia. There will be a badge for you at the registration desk; this entitles you to attend all the workshop sessions, including the luncheons.
