SUBJECT: AMENDMENTS TO CONSTRUCTION PERMITS FOR GRAND GULF
NUCLEAR STATION, UNIT NOS. 1 AND 2

The Commission has issued the enclosed Amendments No. 5 to Construction Permits CPPR-118 and CPPR-119. These amendments are in response to your request of July 10, 1979 as supplemented by your letter of September 12, 1979. These amendments allow a change in the Environmental Projection Program to delete a requirement for monitoring and documenting stage and correlating stage with surface water quality measurements.

We have evaluated the potential for environmental impact of the proposed amendments. It is the staff's conclusion that these changes in the Environmental Protection Program are acceptable. Having made this determination, we have further concluded that the amendments involve action which is insignificant from the standpoint of environmental impact, and pursuant to 10 CFR Sections 51.5(d)(4), an environmental impact statement, negative declaration, or environmental impact appraisal need not be prepared in connection with the issuance of these amendments.

NOTICE OF ISSUANCE OF AMENDMENTS TO CONSTRUCTION PERMITS

Notice is hereby given that the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (the Commission) has issued Amendments No. 5 to Construction Permits CPPR-118 and CPPR-119 issued to the Mississippi Power & Light Company et al. for construction of the Grand Gulf Nuclear Station, Unit Nos. 1 and 2. These amendments allow a change in the Environmental Protection Program to delete a requirement for monitoring and documenting stage and correlating stage with surface water quality measurements. The amendments are effective as of the date of issuance.

The application for the amendments complies with the standards and requirements of the Atomic Energy Act of 1954, as amended, and the Commission's rules and regulations. Prior public notice of these amendments is not required since the amendments do not involve a significant hazards consideration.

The Commission has determined that the issuance of these amendments will not result in any significant environmental impact and that pursuant to 10 CFR Section 51.5(d)(4), an environmental impact statement or negative declaration and environmental impact appraisal need not be prepared in connection with issuance of these amendments.
