These topics were described in a May 18, 2001, staff letter to NEI (ADAMS accession no. ML011410321), and they are: (1) Individual Plant Examination or Individual Plant Examination for External Events as a source document to consider for scoping, (2) operating experience with cracking of small-bore piping, (3) management of loss of preload on reactor vessel internals bolting using the loose parts monitoring system, (4) operating experience with cracking in bolting, and (5) inspection of fire protection systems.
