In order to lend further assistance to surplus labor areas, an April 11, 1958 letter from Gordon Gray, Director, Office of Defense Mobilization, to Chairman Strauss referred to the fact that Defense Manpower Policy No. 4 includes a statement of policy as follows:

"It is the policy of the Federal Government to encourage the placing of new facilities, as well as contracts, in surplus labor areas."

In response to Bureau of the Budget Bulletin No. 58-5, Procurement Memorandum No. 90 was forwarded to you. The memorandum specified the actions to be taken in order to achieve the policy objectives of placing orders and contracts with firms located in areas of substantial labor surplus.

In his letter to Chairman Strauss, Mr. Gray requested that the provisions of DMP 4 with reference to the placing of new facilities in surplus labor areas also be brought to your attention. In this connection, it is my purpose to emphasize the provisions of AEC Manual Chapter 6202-03 which stipulate as follows:

"It is the policy of AEC to give consideration to the interest of other Federal Agencies, including the policies of the Office of Defense Mobilization with respect to distressed surplus labor areas."
