On March 4, 1982, the Nuclear Regulatory Commission issued Amendment No. 29 to Facility Operating License No. NPF-6 for the Arkansas Nuclear One Unit 2 plant. The amendment deleted license condition number 2.C.3.(h) related to installation of a second main feedwater isolation valve and made modifications to the Technical Specifications. This condition was incorrectly identified as condition number 2.C.3.L in Amendment No. 29. Amendment No. 29 should have referred to the deleted condition as number 2.C.3.(h) instead of 2.C.3.L. Condition 2.C.3.1 was deleted by Amendment No. 24 issued June 19, 1981.
