## VIRGINIA ELECTRIC AND POWER COMPANY **NORTH ANNA POWER STATION UNITS 1 AND 2** SUPPLEMENTAL RESPONSE CLARIFYING ANSWER TO ORDER FOR INTERIM SAFEGUARDS AND SECURITY COMPENSATORY MEASURES

On February 25, 2002, the Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) issued an Order for Interim Safeguards and Security Compensatory Measures (the Order) to all operating nuclear power reactor licensees.
