OF INTERMEDIATE PARENT COMPANY OF OWNER OF

DONALD C. COOK NUCLEAR PLANT

The attached analysis constitutes our financial qualifications review input to the safety evaluation for the Donald C. Cook Nuclear Station, Units 1 and 2 (CNP), on the application submitted by Indiana Michigan Power Company (I&M), dated March 28, 2002. The application requests the Commission's consent to the indirect transfer of the facility operating licenses for CNP due to a corporate restructuring of American Electric Power Company (current parent company) that will result in an affiliate company, Central and South West Corporation, becoming an intermediate parent company of I&M.

The basis for the staff's review is 10 CFR 50.80(a) which states, "No license for a production or utilization facility, or any right thereunder, shall be transferred, assigned, or in any manner disposed of, either voluntarily or involuntarily, through transfer of control of the license to any person, unless the Commission shall give its consent in writing."

With respect to our financial qualifications review, the staff concludes that I&M will be qualified to continue to hold the owner-operator licenses of CNP as described herein, and that the indirect transfer of control of I&M is otherwise consistent with applicable provisions of law, regulation, and orders issued by the Commission.
