Dear Mr. Mulligan:

Your e-mail dated May 30, 2002, addressed to Victor Dricks for Mr. William D. Travers, Executive Director for Operations, has been referred to the Office of Nuclear Reactor Regulation pursuant to 10 CFR 2.206 of the Commission's regulations. A copy of your e-mail is enclosed for completeness, and is also available in the Nuclear Regulatory Commission's (NRC's) document management system, ADAMS, under the accession number ML021560570.

Your May 30, 2002, e-mail forwards a previous e-mail from you to Victor Dricks dated March 18, 2002, and states that you have not received a response to the March 18, 2002, e-mail. Our practice at the NRC is to respond to all correspondence, yet we missed getting your correspondence into our tracking system. I apologize for this error. The NRC staff has processed your request following the guidance in Management Directive 8.11, "Review Process for 10 CFR 2.206 Petitions." You requested the following NRC enforcement-related actions: "I request the safety stand-down and shutdown of the following facilities until Exelon stabilizes: Limerick, TMI, Peach Bottom, LaSalle and Oyster Creek."

As the basis for your request you referenced a Peach Bottom Licensee Event Report (LER), NRC Inspection Reports, and excerpts from Internet message boards and Internet newspaper articles. The NRC staff is already aware of the information in the LER and the NRC Inspection Reports. The information discussed on the Internet is primarily opinions related to possible unionization of the work force at certain Exelon nuclear plants, which is an issue outside of NRC's purview. The NRC staff has concluded that your submittal does not meet the criteria for consideration under 10 CFR 2.206 because your petition presents no significant new information related to the safe operation of these facilities. No NRC enforcement-related action is warranted based upon the information you have presented.

Thank you for your interest in the safe operation of our country's nuclear power plants.
