5 Period that comply with all Northern District of California Bankruptcy Local Rules and
6 Compensation Guidelines and the Guidelines of the Office of the United States Trustee.

7 7. The Firm has served a copy of this Application (without Exhibits) on the
8 Special Notice List in this case.

9 8. Pursuant to this Court's "ORDER ESTABLISHING INTERIM FEE
10 APPLICATION AND EXPENSE REIMBURSEMENT PROCEDURE" which was entered on
11 or about May 10, 2002, the Debtor is authorized to make the payment requested herein without a
12 further hearing or order of this Court unless an objection to this Application is filed with the
13 Court by the Debtor, the Committee or the United States Trustee and served by the fifteenth day
14 of the month following the service of this Application. If such an objection is filed, Debtor is
15 authorized to pay the amounts, if any, not subject to the objection. The Firm is informed and
16 believe that this Cover Sheet Application was mailed by first class mail, postage prepaid, on or
17 about May 10, 2002.

18 9. This interim compensation and reimbursement of expenses sought in this
19 Application is on account and is not final. Upon the conclusion of this case, the Firm will seek
20 fees and reimbursement of the expenses incurred for the totality of the services rendered in the
21 case. Any interim fees or reimbursement of expenses approved by this Court and received by the
22 Firm (along with the Firm's retainer) will be credited against such final fees and expenses as may
23 be allowed by this Court.

1 10. The Firm represents and warrants that its billing practices comply with all
2 Northern District of California Bankruptcy Local Rules and Compensation Guidelines and the
3 Guidelines of the Office of the United States Trustee. Neither the Firm nor any members of the
4 Firm has any agreement or understanding of any kind or nature to divide, pay over or share any
5 portion of the fees or expenses to be awarded to the Firm with any other person or attorney
6 except as among the members and associates of the Firm.

7 WHEREFORE, the Firm respectfully requests that the Debtor pay
8 compensation to the Firm as requested herein pursuant to and in accordance with the terms of the
9 "ORDER ESTABLISHING INTERIM FEE APPLICATION AND EXPENSE
10 REIMBURSEMENT PROCEDURE."
