of Canada Limited ("AECL-RCC")


Further to our letter to you in August 1988 concerning the above subject, we are now able to inform you that the reorganization and share transfer transactions was completed on September 30, 1988 and NII will continue the business operations of AECL-RCC on October 1st, 1988.

We trust that all our requests for adjustments to licences, certificates, permits, or other authorizations have been acted upon and will be in order for the continuation of the business without disruption or inconvenience to our customers. In particular, we understand from our discussions with USNRC staff that customers having licences, certificates or permits to operate using products formerly supplied by AECL-RCC will be able to receive the same product supplied by NII from October 1st onward. It is our further understanding that such customers will not be considered to have breached the regulations if they receive such products before submitting an application for an amendment to their licences.
