Dear General Joslin:

I recall that in our very pleasant and informative meeting at the Authority last September, we discussed the development of site and design criteria for power reactors. At that time, as I mentioned to you, the AEC was working on further drafts of power and test reactor site criteria and you informed me you were engaged in the preparation of "codes of practice" for various types of reactors. As I recall, you expected that you might be in a position to make copies of some of the codes of practice available to us early this year.

I am enclosing for your information several copies of proposed site criteria which the Commission has issued for public comment. Although we have not yet received any written comments on them, the informal reactions we have received appear generally to be favorable.

If any of your codes of practice have reached a point where you could furnish me with copies, I would certainly appreciate receiving them.
