Enclosed is a copy of the Federal Register NRC Bi-Weekly Notices of Applications and Amendments to Operating Licenses Involving No Significant Hazards Considerations dated September 25, 1985.

Three notices for Callaway are contained in this publication: They are:

1. Revision to Technical Specification Figure 6.2-2 to reflect an organizational title change, Page 38922;
2. Revision to Technical Specification 4.7.10.1.2.c to allow the 18-month inspection of the fire pump diesel engines to be performed when the plant is at power, instead of only when the plant is shutdown, Page 38923, and
3. Extension of the initial 18-month surveillance interval for manual initiations of the reactor trip system and engineered safety features actuation system (ESFAS), portions of diesel generator testing, ESFAS actuations on safety injection and loss of offsite power, containment spray actuation testing, Phase A and B containment isolations and a Class 1E battery service test, Page 38925.
