Amendment No. 9 deletes the requirements for resistance testing of certain fuses whose function is to provide containment penetration conductor overcurrent protection. Amendment No. 9 also deletes the list of containment penetration conductor overcurrent protective devices from the technical specifications.

Amendment No. 10 revised the unit organizational chart to reflect an organizational title change from Supervisor, Radwaste to Superintendent, Radwaste.

The pre-notice announcing the proposed amendment request is to revise Technical Specification 3/4.6.1.6 regarding containment vessel structural integrity.
