
On February 12, 1990 the Commission issued Amendment No. 50 to the Callaway Operating License No. NPF-30. The amendment relocates the existing procedural details of the current Radiological Effluent Technical Specifications (RETS) to the Offsite Dose Calculation Manual (ODCM), and procedural details for the solid radioactive wastes to the Process Control Program (PCP). The amendment also incorporates the respective programmatic controls into the Administrative Controls section of the Technical Specifications.

Union Electric is transmitting this confirmatory letter that all procedural changes associated with Amendment No. 50 have been implemented.
