SUBJECT: SUMMARY OF MEETING WITH THE NUCLEAR ENERGY INSTITUTE

(NEI) ON THE LICENSE RENEWAL INTERIM STAFF GUIDANCE

PROCESS

On February 25, 2002, the U. S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission staff met with the NEI and other industry representatives to discuss the NRC's license renewal interim staff guidance (ISG) process. The license renewal ISG was previously provided to NEI and the Union of Concerned Scientists (UCS) by letter dated December 21, 2001 (ADAMS Accession Number ML013550265). The meeting agenda is provided in Attachment 1. A list of meeting attendees is provided in Attachment 2.

After a few clarifying questions on the process, NEI stated that it was still soliciting comments on the process from its members. NEI indicated that shortly following the meeting it would provide its coordinated comments.

On March 1, 2002, NEI provided a list of comments by electronic mail to the staff. A copy of the comments is provided in Attachment 3.

The staff is reviewing NEI's comments and will issue a revised license renewal ISG process by separate correspondence. No comments were received from the UCS.

Staff Guidance for Updating the Improved License Renewal Guidance Documents dated December 21, 2001

Section 4.2.3.2 - Description

Add the following sentence:

The ISG will be identified as generically applicable or applicable to a specific scope (e.g. BWRs only).

Section 4.2.3.2 - References

Revise the second sentence to read:

These could include the ASME and ANSI Codes, NUREGs, other ISGs, Part 54 subsections, and Regulator Guides

Appendix B flow chart - applicants portion and

Section 4.2.4 – Implementation of the ISG

Revise the second paragraph to read:

.....At this point, the ISG will have a number designation representing the year and issue number (i.e. 01-01) and an implementation date. The ISG can then be referenced in an applicant's LRA or as a part of the LRA regulatory review process. Implementation of the ISG by the applicant may vary due to the complexity of the ISG and timing of the applicant's LRA submittal.

Section 4.2.4 - Implementation of the ISG

General Comment

This section is written assuming the ISG will be issued with or without stakeholder agreement. Those without stakeholder agreement may be appealed to NRC management. There is no guidance provided for ISGs that are withdrawn by the NRC after stakeholder interactions.

Section 4.2.4 - Implementation of the ISG

Include the following sentence to be consistent with the Appendix B flowchart:

ISGs will remain effective until incorporated in Improved License Renewal Guidance Documents.
