On March 18, 2002, Entergy Nuclear Operations, Inc. (ENO) submitted its initial response (Reference 2) to the Interim Safeguards and Security Compensatory Measures Order (Order, Reference 1) issued by the United States Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) on February 25, 2002. Entergy also submitted a request for an extension of time to submit an answer for Sections B.2.a.(1), B.2.a.(2), and B.2.b of the Order (Reference 3)

Pursuant to the requirements of 10 CFR § 50.4 the attachment to this letter contains Entergy's supplemental response to Sections B.2.a.(1), B.2.a.(2), and B.2.b of the Order. This response supercedes and replaces the response submitted with Reference 2 for Sections B.2.a.(1), B.2.a.(2), and B.2.b. The attached response also identifies the current schedule dates for completion of the Order requirements based upon the latest available information. As required by the Order the actions to implement the Order have been started and unless relief has been


