**PETITIONERS' UNOPPOSED MOTION FOR AN ENLARGEMENT OF TIME
TO RESPOND TO MOTION TO DISMISS**

Pursuant to Federal Rule of Appellate Procedure 26, and to Local Circuit Rule 27, petitioners respectfully file this unopposed motion to enlarge the time period in which to respond to the Motion to Dismiss filed on behalf of respondent in the above-captioned case. Counsel for petitioners has spoken with counsel for both respondent Nuclear Regulatory Commission ("NRC") and prospective intervenor Nuclear Energy Institute ("NEI") regarding this request for extension. Counsel for both NRC and NEI have consented to this extension.

The Motion to Dismiss was filed on May 28, 2002. In accordance with Federal Rule of Appellate Procedure 27, petitioners have until Monday, June 10, 2002, to file their response. Due to the press of other business and the important issues raised by the Motion to Dismiss, which presents a challenge to this Court's subject-matter jurisdiction, petitioners request a very short enlargement of time of three days, so that their response would be due on June 13, 2002.

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For the foregoing reasons, petitioners respectfully request that the Court grant their unopposed motion to enlarge the time allowed to respond to the Motion to Dismiss such that the response shall be due no later than June 13, 2002.
