Gentlemen:

In accordance with 10 CFR 50.54(p)(2), Carolina Power & Light (CP&L) Company is providing Revision 8 of the Security Personnel Training & Qualification Plan (TQP) for the Brunswick Steam Electric Plant (BSEP), Unit Nos. 1 and 2. The changes described in this submittal were effective on June 13, 2002.

A summary description of the changes is provided in Enclosure 1. Enclosure 2 provides an evaluation of the changes that demonstrates the changes do not decrease the safeguards effectiveness of the Physical Security and Safeguards Contingency Plan. A copy of the revised TQP is provided in Enclosure 3.

Enclosures 1, 2, and 3 to this letter do not contain Safeguards Information and are not subject to 10 CFR 73.21 restrictions. However, these enclosures do contain licensee physical protection information. Therefore CP&L requests that Enclosures 1, 2, and 3 of this letter be withheld from public disclosure in accordance with 10 CFR 2.790(d)(1).
