SUBJECT: PALO VERDE NUCLEAR GENERATING STATION (PVNGS), UNIT 1, REVISION  
TO RELOAD ANALYSIS REPORT (TAC NO. 71873)

On September 19, 1989, the Commission issued Amendment No. 44 to Facility Operating License No. NPF-41 for PVNGS, Unit 1. The staff's Safety Evaluation in support of the amendment was based, in part, on the Unit 1, Cycle 3 Reload Analysis Report (RAR).

By letter dated January 25, 1990, Arizona Public Service Company submitted a revision to that RAR. The revision reflected the replacement of eight new fuel assemblies which were required as a result of damage to one new fuel assembly during core alteration.

Based on our review of your January 25, 1990 submittal, we conclude that our Safety Evaluation and bases thereto regarding Amendment No. 44 remain valid, and that the amendment is unaffected by the revision.
