I appreciate the opportunity to speak with the NRC regarding the short term (40 years) storage of spent fuel from nuclear reactors on the Utah Indian Reservation at Skull Valley.

I would offer an alternative site. Located near Maybell, Colorado, the Dept. of Energy has a UMTRA reclamation site adjacent to the proposed storage site. It is known in Dept. of Energy, Colorado Dept. Public Health and Environment and the BLM, as the Johnson Pit. It was the original proposed site for the UMTRA reclamation site. The storage capacity is 10 million cu. yds. That amount is surely sufficient for the short term storage of the spent fuel proposed to go to the Goshute Ute Indians.
