

Dear Sir or Madam:

For the reporting period of 1/01/01 – 6/30/01 data entry input errors, resulting in **incorrect reporting of actual For-Cause: Post-Accident Testing Results**, were self-identified by annual Departmental self-assessment of the Fitness for Duty Program. Specifically, the number of For-Cause: Post Accident testing results reported for *Long-Term Contractors* (1), and *Short-Term Contractors* (2), was incorrect. A detailed review of data supporting the subject reporting period confirmed no post accident for-cause testing was performed, and the data should have been reported in the Pre-Access / # Tested fields.
