Dear Mr. Peifer:

On May 30, 2002, the U. S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission issued Amendment No. 246 to Facility Operating License No. DPR-49 for the Duane Arnold Energy Center. The amendment changed Technical Specification 3.0.3 to allow a longer time before entering a limiting condition for operation in the event of a missed surveillance and added requirements to (1) perform a risk evaluation for any surveillance delayed greater than 24 hours and (2) manage the risk impact, in response to your application dated March 28, 2002.

We are reissuing a corrected copy of Page 2 of Amendment No. 246. Paragraph 2.C.(2) contained incorrect words that are not part of the Duane Arnold Energy Center license.

We apologize for any inconvenience this may have caused.
