Enclosed copy of the Notice of Consideration of Issuance of Amendment to Facility Operating License, Proposed No Significant Hazards Consideration Determination, and Opportunity for a Hearing, is related to your application for amendment, dated May 20, 2002, as supplemented by your letter dated June 19, 2002. The proposed amendment would revise the Cooper Nuclear Station Technical Specifications to permit increase in the cooling water temperature limits of Sections 3.7.2, "Service Water (SW) System and Ultimate Heat Sink (UHS)," and 3.7.3, "Reactor Equipment Cooling (REC) System." Pursuant to 10 CFR 50.91(a)(6) you requested the staff to process the amendment on an exigent basis. The Nuclear Regulatory Commission staff is processing your request accordingly.

The enclosed notice is being sent to the Office of *Federal Register* for publication and solicitation of public comments.
