In Reference 1, Exelon Generation Company, LLC (Exelon) and AmerGen Energy Company, LLC (AmerGen), responded to the NRC Order for Interim Safeguards and Security Compensatory Measures ("Order") issued on February 25, 2002. We indicated in our response and in Reference 2 that additional time was needed to complete the necessary evaluations to determine what actions

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were appropriate and what an appropriate schedule for implementation would be with respect to certain Interim Compensatory Measures (ICMs) (i.e., ICMs B.2.a.(1), B.2.a.(2), B.2.b, and B.4.i) before we could submit a schedule for achieving compliance with those requirements, in accordance with Section III.C.1 of the Order. We completed those evaluations with respect to the remainder of those ICMs and are providing the required compliance schedule under separate cover.

Reference 3 indicates that resolution of ICM B.1.c for TMI Unit 1 will require more communication between the NRC and AmerGen staffs. In accordance with 10 CFR 50.4, AmerGen, hereby submits its supplemental response to the Order related to ICM B.1.c for TMI Unit 1.

The attachment to this letter contains Safeguards Information. Therefore, it is requested that the attachment be withheld from public disclosure as Safeguards Information in accordance with 10 CFR 73.21, “Requirements for the Protection of Safeguards Information.”

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
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
