SUBJECT: SUMMARY OF MEETING HELD ON JUNE 10, 2002, WITH
WESTINGHOUSE ELECTRIC COMPANY REGARDING POTENTIAL
ADVANCES IN SAFETY ANALYSIS

On June 10, 2002, representatives of Westinghouse Electric Company met with the NRC staff to present their potential advances on safety analysis methods. A representative of Framatome also attended the meeting.

Westinghouse gave an overview of the objectives, which included best estimate loss-of-coolant accident (BELOCA) initiatives under consideration, regulatory interpretations supporting implementation, a target schedule, and solicited NRC feedback. The meeting continued with a discussion of current Westinghouse BELOCA methodology, industry developments, and a comparative study. Westinghouse further discussed their understanding of the scope of the NRC staff's review, as well as revised regulatory interpretations under consideration.

Westinghouse presented the information to the NRC staff and intends to submit the proposal in the future. At the conclusion of the meeting, the staff expressed their appreciation to Westinghouse for the presentation of potential advances in safety analysis methods.
