I. <u>SECY-02-0094 - Pacific Gas & Electric Co. (Diablo Canyon Power Plant, Units 1 and 2);</u> Multiple Petitions to Intervene

The Commission approved a Memorandum and Order responding to multiple petitions to intervene and requests to hold in abeyance or dismiss the proceeding in the license transfer application submitted by Pacific Gas & Electric Co. The Memorandum and Order denies the intervention petitions of the California Public Utilities Commission (CPUC), the County of San Luis Obispo (the County), and the Official Committee of Unsecured Creditors of PG&E, but grants CPUC and the County participant status in this proceeding if a hearing is granted on the petition of any other petitioner. The Memorandum and Order also denies the petitioners' procedural motions and reserves ruling on the remaining two antitrust-based petitions filed by other petitioners.
